



## Moses - Water from a Rock Activity

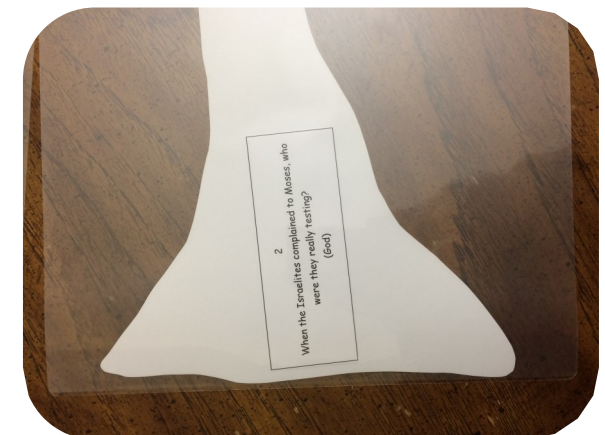
### SUPPLIES NEEDED

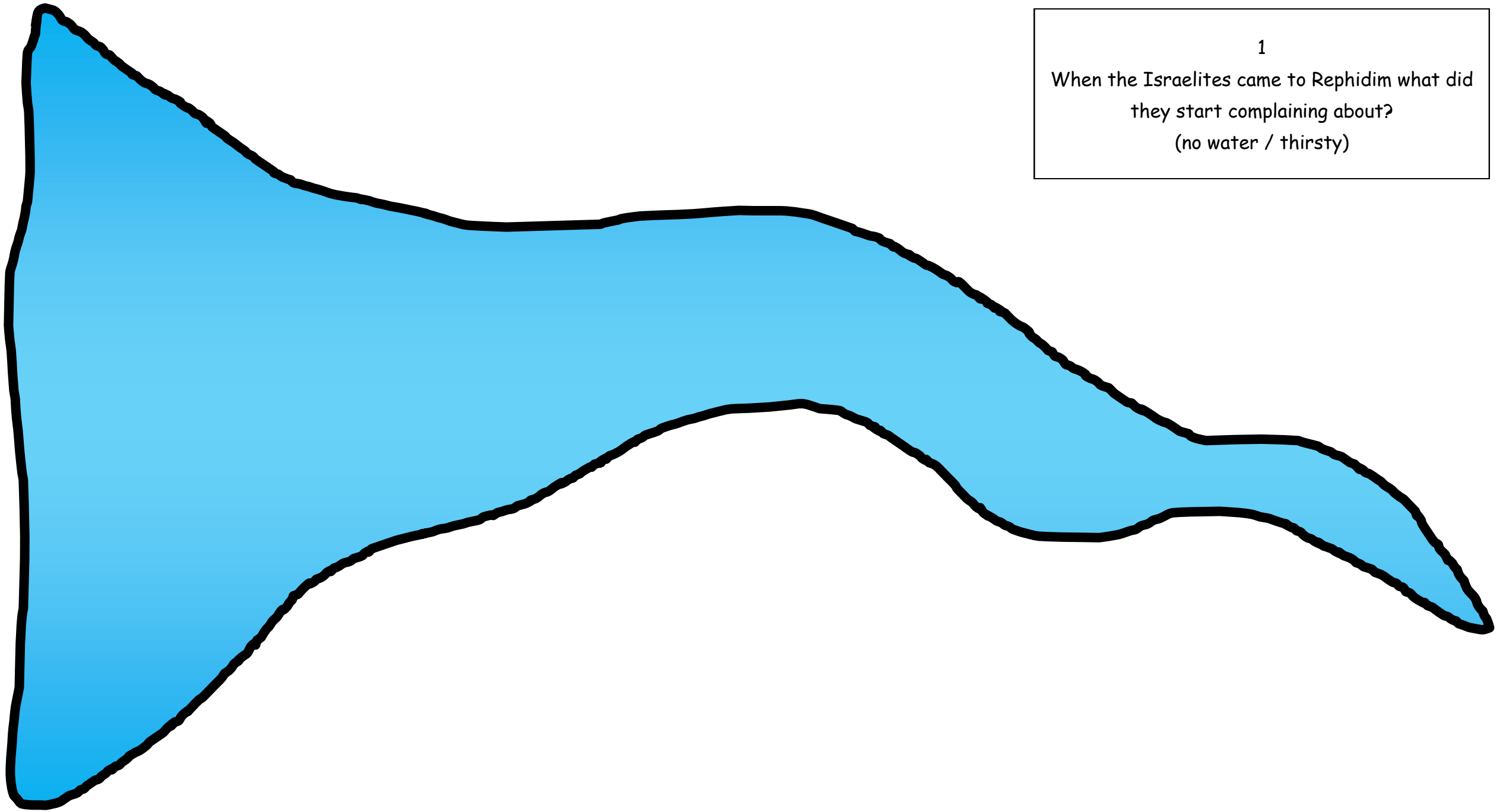
You will need the following:

- 6 Sheets of Cardstock Legal-Size (8.5" x 14")

  - 6 3 mil Laminating Film Legal-Size (8.5" x 14")

  - 1 Large stick or branch (optional)
- Masking Tape

### DIRECTIONS

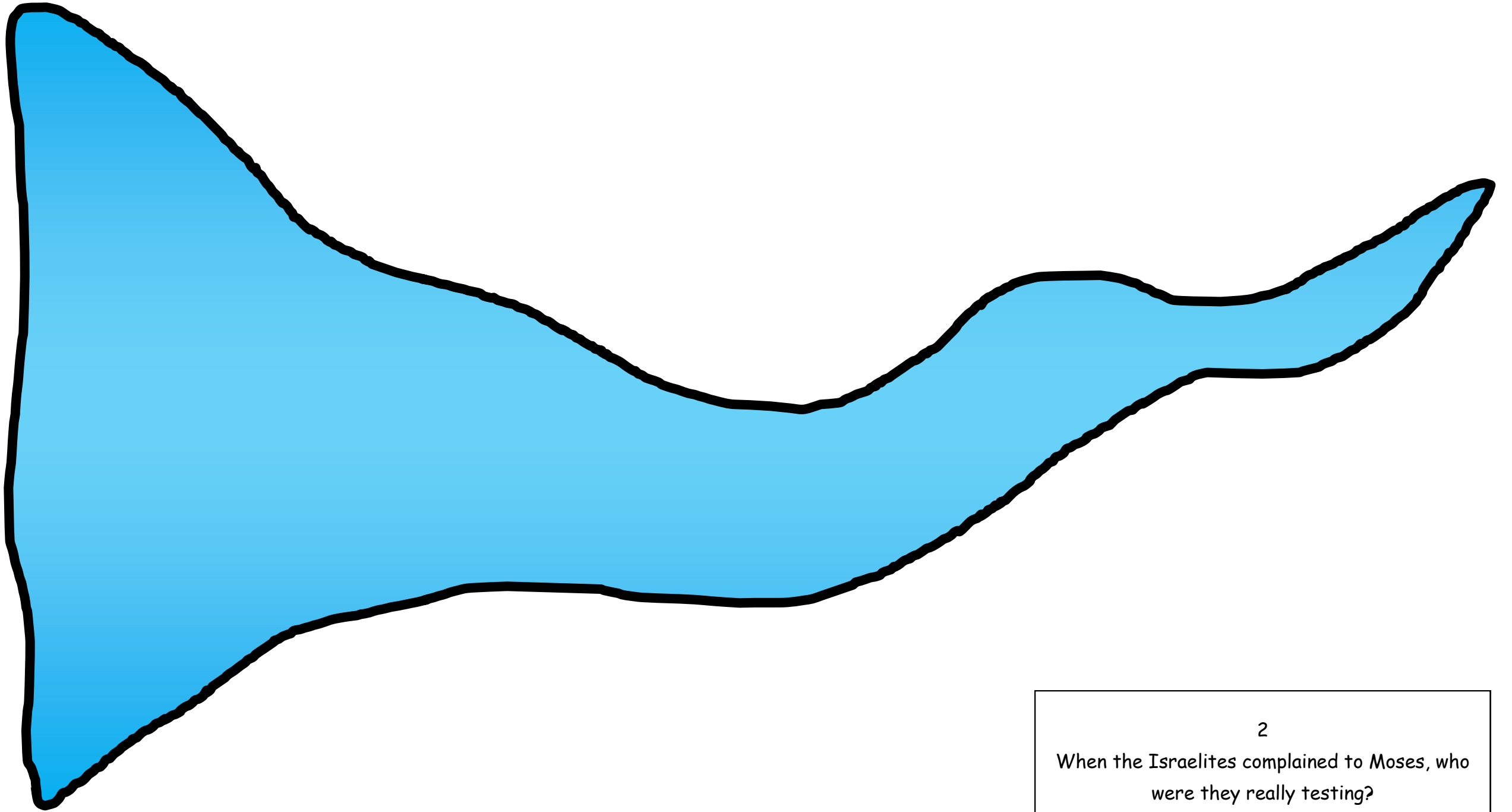
- Print pages 2-7 one-sided on legal cardstock.
- Cut out the streams of water and the questions. Then glue or tape the questions to the back of each stream of water (picture below right).
- Laminate all the streams of water.
- During class, allow the children to take turns answering the questions on the backs of the water streams. After the child answers the question correctly, then they can use the stick and hit the rock. Put tape on the back the water stream and allow the child to put the water where they hit the rock.
- If you don't have a rock painted on a wall in your classroom, use gray posterboards cut out to look like a rock. Then you can attach the water streams with clear Velcro dots.



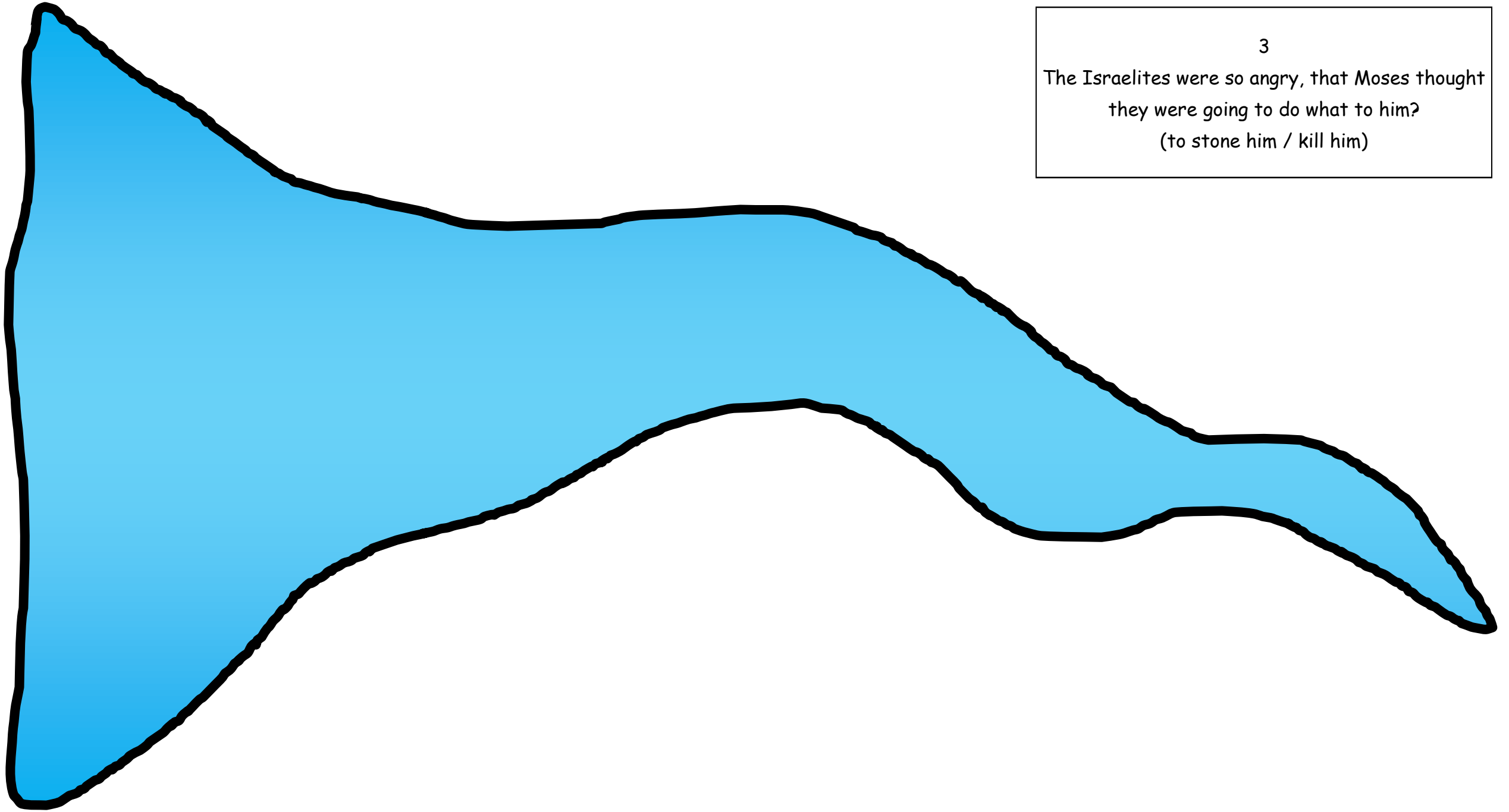

(no water / thirsty)

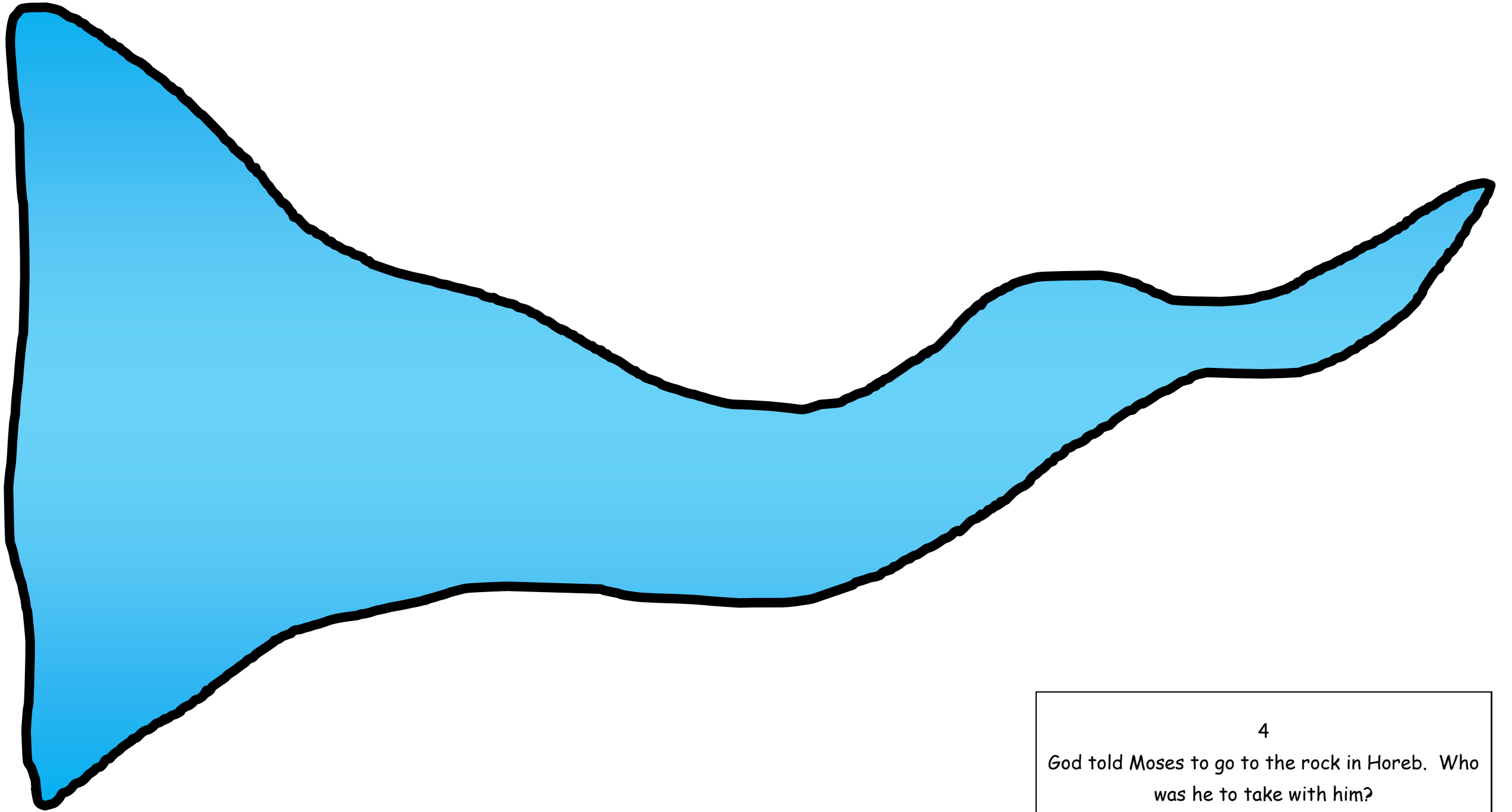

(God)

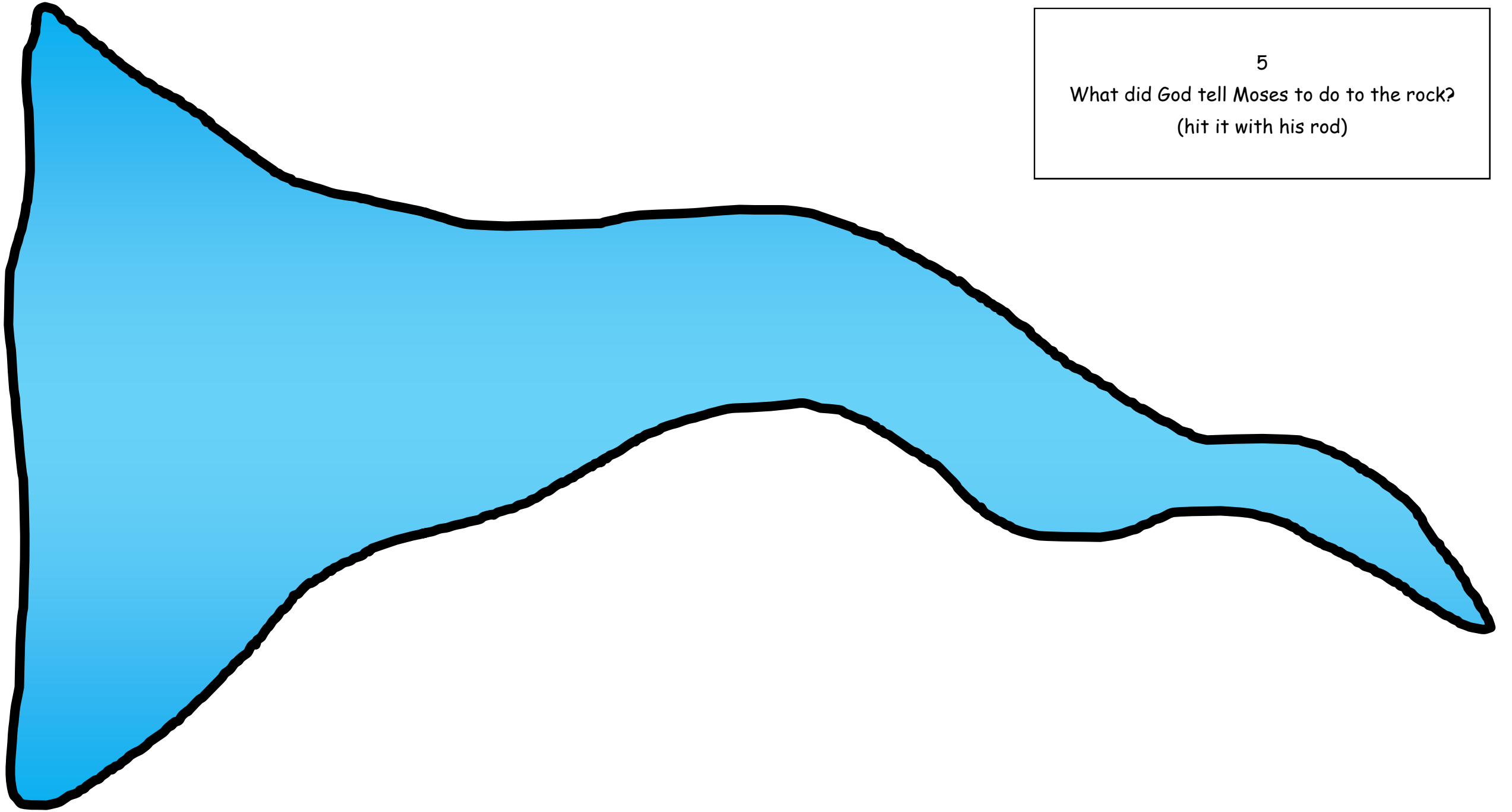

(to stone him / kill him)

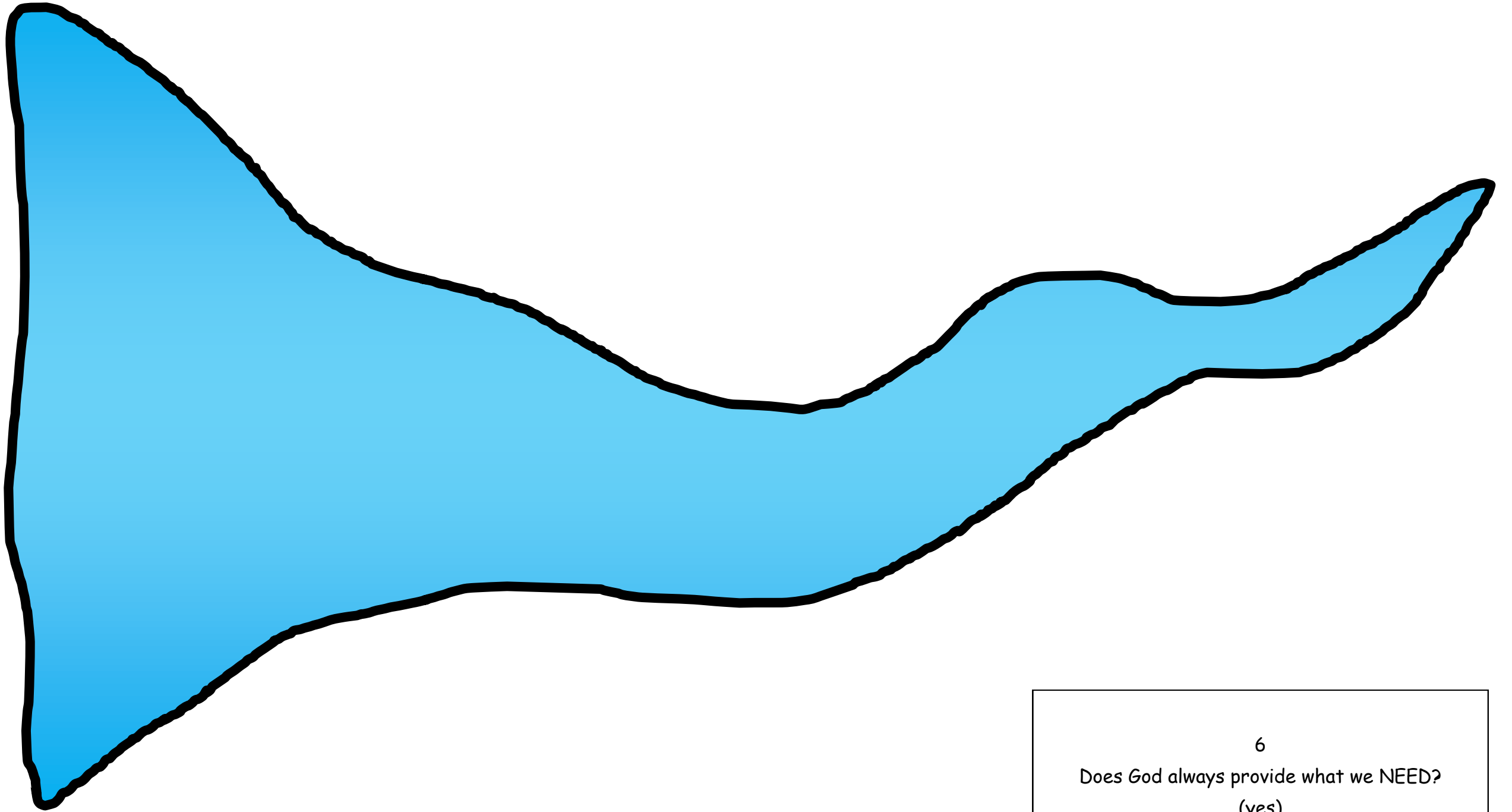
